



AGREEMENT BETWEEN
Telecommunications Technology Association (TTA) of Korea
AND
Information and Communication Technology Standards Advisory Council of
Canada (ISACC)

GENERAL

1. This agreement forms the basis of cooperation, transparency and in particular the mutual access to ICT standards deliverables developed for the national application, in the supportive context of international standardization.
2. The purpose of the agreement is to foster closer appreciation and insight in ICT standards, their creation and availability, between interested participants in Canada and Korea.
3. The Telecommunications Technology Association (TTA) of Korea is recognized by the Korean Communication Commission (KCC) as the Korean organization which establishes standards in the field of ICT. The national coordination and cooperation with of international standardization bodies, including ITU, APT and 3GPPs is also committed to TTA by the KCC.
4. The Information and Communication Technology Standards Advisory Council of Canada (ISACC) is an Industry/Government initiative established under the aegis of Industry Canada and the Standards Council of Canada. ISACC is the forum in Canada which provides a focus for the development and implementation of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) standards strategies for Canada at the national and international/global levels. ISACC is open to all organizations which are actively involved in the ICT standards development.



THE UNDERSIGNED ORGANIZATIONS AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

5. A systematic exchange between ISACC and TTA, of listings of standards deliverables adopted for national purposes and where called upon, exchange of the standards cited in the listings.

6. The dissemination in ISACC and TTA of documents received from each other will be strictly limited to the members of these organizations. The copy right of these documents is not transferred.

7. No official comments are sought or expected on the contents of the documents. However, unofficial comments will be conveyed to the appropriate working group for its attention, and without prejudice to the substance or time-scales of the work.

8. The ISACC and TTA may mutually exchange views and information on the status of information and communication technology standardizations in both countries, and may see fit to conduct visits in order to further mutual understanding and transparency between both organizations.
